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RigMaster Power Corp. recently announced a score of new product options and upgrades that focus on reducing maintenance, improving serviceability and shortening installation times for their 2006 model APU.

The redesign sees a number of almost invisible component upgrades that combine for some rather impressive results in terms of reducing maintenance and shortening installation. A significant and easily seen improvement is the new larger capacity oil pan which will extend maintenance intervals. An enhanced cooling system and controller software upgrades are some other good examples of the “doing things smarter” philosophy. In total the design modifications made for the ‘06 model are estimated to cut preventative maintenance costs by up to 50%.

While RigMaster’s stand alone design already provides the shortest installation time in the APU industry, the new model promises an even faster install. Utilizing a new universal mounting system that will improve compatibility with all Class 8 models and a new factory installed integral muffler, installation for the ‘06 models should be cut by 15%, compared to previous models.

“You may not see all the changes and improvements we made for the 2006 model right away but, I guarantee you will notice an increase in reliability and serviceability” explained Gary Lisson, RigMaster’s General Manager. RigMaster is so confident about the new design that they are offering the 2006 model with a 2 year, 4,000 hour comprehensive warranty; a marked increase over the currently offered one year, unlimited hours warranty.

Alongside the improved designed, RigMaster will be available with some optional upgrades. One of the new offerings available for the popular truck mounted APU will be the option to choose your RigMaster equipped with a 13 HP CAT engine. The RigMaster will continue to come standard with the reliable Perkins 400 series engine but will offer the optional upgrade for customers who see the value of the CAT engine.

The popular AutoStart feature will remain an optional feature for RigMaster, but has been upgraded to include fully automatic low voltage battery monitoring, along with date and time AutoStart programming and automatic temperature control start up/shut down. Drivers will no longer have to worry about whether or not their truck will start after an extended absence.

The 2006 model is the culmination of a redesign/improvement project that began in late 2004. Some of the changes that were implemented in 2005 include an increase in generator power to 6,000W, a 60 AMP alternator, a dual engine fan system and all-weather coatings for most components.

Lisson is enthusiastic about the many new offerings that 2006 will bring for their customers, "We've streamlined the design, added a lot of new features and options and put together an incredible offering that our customers will love and cannot be matched by another APU on the market today."

With the increase in competition the market has seen in the past year and the strong forecast for this technology, the '06 model RigMaster APU will maintain its position as a premium APU.
